SUGGESTED TIPS TO HELP PROTECT YOU:

When Shopping Online

- Be sure to only use websites with which you are familiar – many bogus sites collect your information and then may sell it online
- Always make sure you log out of a website and then close the browser – not closing out can leave an open connection for a thief
- Don't click on a link of any website in an email; make sure you enter the actual website address
- Remember when you click 'OK' or 'Yes' on a website you are probably committing to a charge on your card
- Look for a seal of authentication such as VeriSign® which when clicked will tell you who owns/operates the website

When Using the ATM

- Make sure no one is watching you enter your PIN
- Check the card reader of the ATM to make sure there is not a 'skimmer' over the card reader
- Always be sure to get your card, money and receipt out of the machine as quickly as possible
- Don't use a PIN that is easily figured out (last 4 digits of phone #, SS#...)
- Contact the Police immediately at 911 if you feel insecure at an ATM

When Banking Online

- Don't use a simple password; easy passwords are an identity thief's dream; use a combination of upper and lower case letters, numbers and special characters. Make your password 8 digits or more for the best protection
- Never leave your online banking session unattended; always log off
- Make sure you maintain secure up to date virus software
- If you use a public computer (libraries, hotels...) be sure to register the computer as a 'public computer' rather than a 'personal computer' so the system will not retain the 'cookies' in the system
- Always make sure you recognize your multi factor authentication phrase and picture before continuing to log in. This assures you that you are on the **www.legacyar.com** site

When Using Your Debit Card in Person

- Be sure to sign your card and keep it in a secure place on your body
- Never write your PIN on your debit card
- Don't let your debit card out of your sight unless you have to when making a transaction
- Don't give your card to anyone not on your account - even family and friends can and do create fraudulent transactions
